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



- 2) To establish and run education, industrial and vocational training centres and to help in the running of such institutions financially.
  - 3) To conduct nutrition programmes.
  - 4) To conduct poor feeding and generally to give food and clothing and monetary aid to the poor, needy and defectives without distinction of caste or creed and to afford relief to people in flood, famine, pestilence and other, conduct or grant donations for the support of inmates of orphanages.
  - 5) To organise and run any scheme comprising of any of the objects above mentioned tailored to the ambition of the donors.
  - 6) To do such acts and things which are incidental or conducive to the objects of the trust.
  - 7) The above objects shall be independent of each other, and the

Board of Trustees as hereinafter constituted may from time to time apply the funds of the trust in carrying out all or any of the aforesaid objects of the trust as they deem fit.

- 8) The affairs of the trust will be in the hands of the trustees who will not be less than 3 and not more than 6.
- 9) The first board of trustees will consist of the following person:

1. C.Palanivel, S/O Chokkalingam, Jayankonda Cholapuram.
2. Mrs.P.Maheswari, W/O C.Palanivel, Jayankonda Cholapuram.
3. Smt.N.Jayalakshmi, W/O Nataraja, Velippalayam, Nagapattinam.
- 10) At present founder Trustee Mr.C.Palanivel has to act as Managing Trustee of the trust and he will also act as correspondent of the educational institution. He will be paid a minimum remuneration of Rs.1,000/- per month. Any vacancy arising in the office of the managing trustee shall be filled

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up only with his family members either male or female and not from outside. The Trustees working in the institution will be paid Salary as per the Government scales & instructions. The board of trustees shall have the right to appoint persons as trustees and also to co-opt persons in the vacancy caused in the posts of trustee.

- 11) The funds and properties of the trust shall be all and every moneys and properties gifted and conveyed and transferred to the trust for the purpose of carrying out the trust created hereby and all or any income derived from the properties of the trust and additions accretions and augmentations to the aforesaid moneys and properties.
  - 12) The trustees shall manage all the properties of the trust. The Managing Trustee has power to open bank account in the name of the trust on behalf of the trust in any nationalised or scheduled banks. The Managing Trustee is empowered to operate that bank account and to sign in the cheques on behalf

of the trust.


13) The Managing Trustee shall have power to invest the money of the trust;

- a) in any of the securities by section 20 of the Indian Trust Act, 1882.
  - b) in accordance with the provision of the Income-tax Act, 1961 and any rules framed and or to be framed there under in the purchase of lands and building provided that no such investments shall be made unless majority of the Board are satisfied that such investment will be a steady source of income to the trust and will yield a reasonable net income of the outlay or deemed necessary for carrying out the objects of the trust.
  - c) in fixed deposits with any banks, in any other Government approved investments.
  - d) The funds of the trust may at the discretion of the Board be invested in such other manner as may be decided from time to time.
- 14) ~~XXXXXX~~
- If in the opinion of the Board of trustees any property belonging to the trust is deteriorating in value or not yielding a reasonable income or that sale or conversion into property of another kind would be advantageous to the trust, the Board may exchange the same for property of any other kind or shall sell the property and invest the proceeds in the manner herein provided. The trustee may also in their discretion alter, pull down, enlarge, rebuild or add to all or any of the buildings belonging to the trust.
- 15) The Board shall have power to let the property or any buildings

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belonging to the trust or any part thereof for such terms and years at such rent and subject to such condition, stipulations or provisions as the trustee shall determine. The Board shall have also power to mortgage or charge the properties of the trust or any part thereof to secure repayment of any sum or sums or money which the trustees may borrow on the security thereof.

- 16) The Board shall have power to accept from any person or persons or institutions contributions in money and (or) property either by way of addition to the trust funds generally or for any one or more of the specified objects of the trust and in either case such a contribution shall be dealt with either as capital or as income according to the directions of donars at the time of gift.
- 17) The board shall have power to call in and convert into cash the trust properties and realise any or all of the securities and investment and to reinvest them in such manner as they deem fit from time to time.
- 18) The board shall have full power of management of the trust properties and funds and they shall have full control over the finance of the trust.
- 19) The board shall be entitled to take all steps that may be reasonable necessary or required for the preservation of the trust, the trust properties and of the title of the trust to the trust properties.
- 20) The trustees may from time to time formulate and alter the rules and regulations for the proper conduct of the trust and its objects by recording the same in a minute book. Provided that as long as the donations to this trust enjoy the benefits



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of section 80 G of the Indian Income-tax Act  
approval of the Commissioner of Income-tax is required  
formulate and alter the rules and regulations.

- 21) The trustees are hereby authorised to appoint a Secretary  
and to pay him out of the trust fund such as salary as the  
trustees think fit. The trustees can delegate such secre-  
tarial or other work to the Secretary as they deem fit.
- 22) Proper accounts showing all receipts and disbursements  
made on account of the trust hereby constituted shall be  
kept by the trustees and shall be duly audited at least  
once in every year by such auditors as the trustees shall  
appoint from among themselves or by a professionnal  
accountant whom they may employ and pay for the purpose.
- 23) The Managing Trustee shall have power to make generally  
all such acts, deeds and things on behalf of the trust as  
may be necessary or expedient in the administration of  
trust and its also authorised to transact business in  
connection with the trust.
- 24) It is hereby declared that the trust hereby created is  
absolutely irrevocable.
